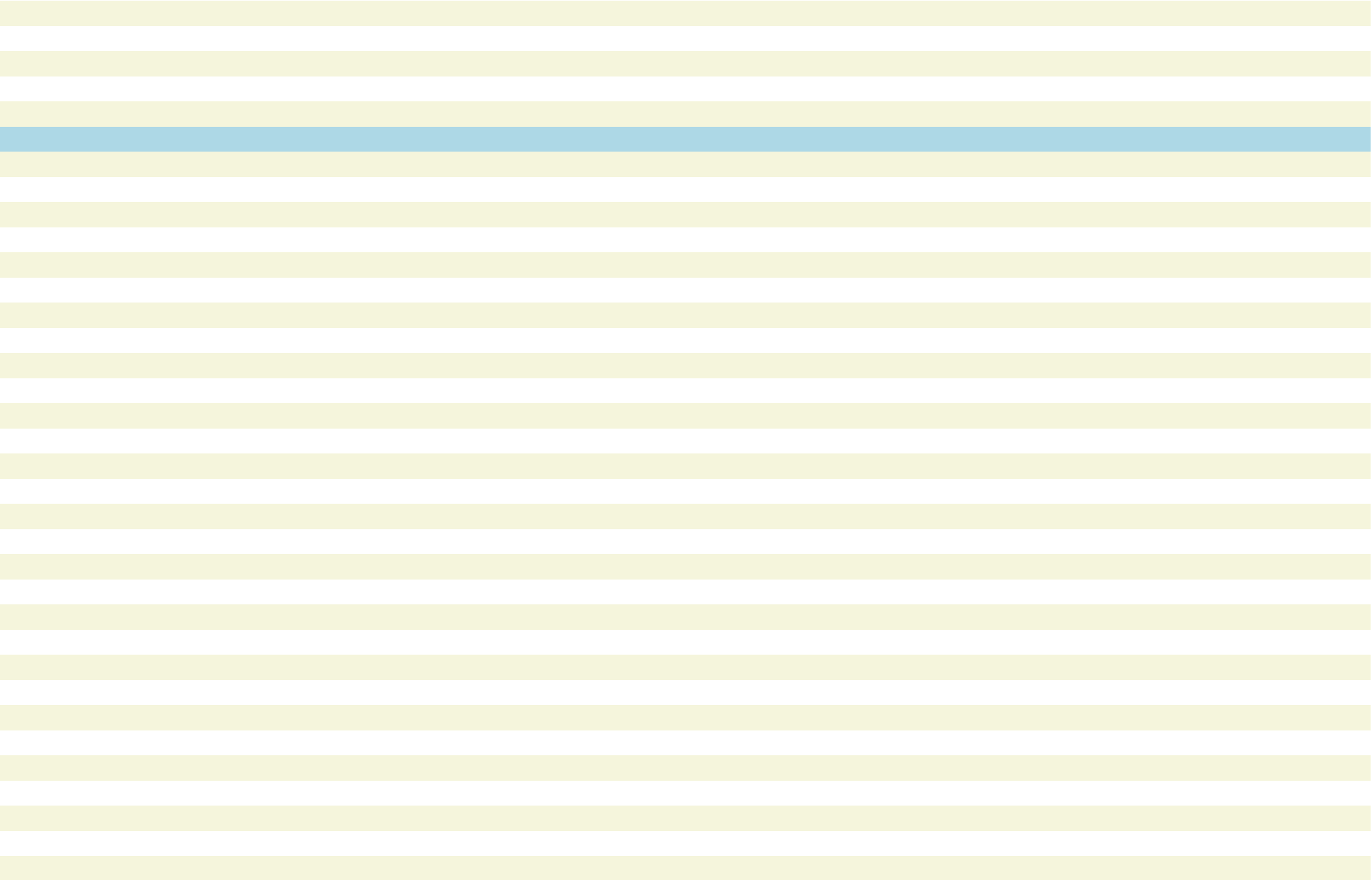

This report shows how many students are eligible for free meals. The enrollment data is as of October 2nd, whereas the counts and percentages of students eligible for free meals reflect updates through November.

The federal government reimburses the District at a set rate for breakfasts and lunches through the National School Breakfast Program and the National School Lunch Program, respectively. Breakfasts and lunches are available to all students at no cost at a site based on two reasons (See Note column):

1. Schools identified as Community Eligibility Provisioning (CEP) schools. Through CEP, the federal government provides meals at no charge to all students, including students who would not normally qualify for free or reduced meals. CEP was developed to reduce paperwork for families and decrease barriers to accessing school meals by using available data to determine the school community's eligibility for this provision; therefore paper applications are not collected or processed for CEP schools.
2. **Head Start** is only available to students from low-income, qualifying families, and all students are eligible for free meals.
3. Provision 2 (**Prov 2**) schools offer meals to all participating students at no charge for a period up to 4 years. During the first year, or base year, the school makes eligibility
