The PPS RESJ Lens is a critical thinking tool used to evaluate the impact of policies, programs, and practices on the equity and social justice of our students.

The following questions are examples of what to consider when making decisions on some policies and strategies.

1. Describe the proposed action, desired results and outcomes, and connection to PPS mission: Every student by name prepared for college, career and participation as an active community member, regardless of race, income or zip code.
