






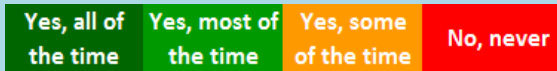


51. How much emphasis does this school place on standardized testing?
