1.20.014-P Board Committees

- (1) Special Board committees may be appointed by the Board for specific purposes to serve until their assignment is completed. A limited number of standing committees may be established. The entire Board may meet as a committee-of-the-whole.
- (2) The function of special Board committees will be to consider actions or issues in detail that would otherwise monopolize the Board agenda and provide policy advice for the Board's action or consideration, as appropriate. Board committees serve in a fact-finding, deliberative and advisory role rather than as a legislative or administrative body. The superintendent or designee will assist in the development of reports and related recommendations as necessary. The committee will make recommendations directly to the Board as a whole, which alone may take actioand ComoliBees and of committees-of-the-whole

will be publicly announced and the public will be permitted to attend. However, the Board and its committees may sit in executive sessions to discuss matters when such sessions are required or permitted by law.


- Proceedings of Board committees will be informal to assure a full exchange of ideas.
- A committee will not have the power to act for the Board except as the Board has specifically authorized, but will make recommendations to the Board. Committee recommendations and reports will become an official part of Board minutes.
