### New Maker Space and CTE Spaces

The fourth phase of the Roosevelt modernization project provides a new 10,000 square-foot addition to improve the school's Maker space and CTE program. It will also connect the current Maker space into a 1,161 square-foot science classroom and connect the current 3,016 square-foot Construction Technology CTE space into the Maker space.

The additional 10,000 square feet will include a 3,250 square-foot Construction Technology CTE space on the second floor. The second floor would include a 1,850 square-foot classroom, which has a flexible partition wall between the classroom. This allows them to become one large classroom as needed.
